Adult Leader Fees	All Adults (full week of camp)	\$100

Payment Schedule

<i>Date</i>	<i>Payment Due</i>	<i>Description</i>
September 4, 2009	\$100	Campsite Reservation Fee. Non-refundable, but transferable. Unpaid reservations will be cancelled.
January 8, 2010	\$250	1st Troop Payment Due; applied toward total camp fees, non-refundable.
March 5, 2010	\$125/Camper	50% of each Scout's fee due. Non-refundable, but transferable to another Scout. Projected camp roster due.
May 7, 2010	\$125/Camper	Remaining balance due for all Scouts & Adults. Final camp roster due (youth & adult).

Except for Webelos Crossovers & new Boy Scouts, all Scout payments postmarked after May 7th will be charged at the rate of \$290 per Scout. All Summer Camp payments are to be paid at the LHAC Service Center, P.O. Box 129, Auburn MI 48611-0129. Payments must be postmarked on or before the due dates; payments postmarked after the due dates are late and will be billed accordingly.

Important Notes & Reminders

- Troops are asked to please pay by a single troop check. Individual checks cause unnecessary delays and can create unit account problems.
- Each Unit or Provisional Scout must have their own camp account. Please do not combine different units, or youth from different units, under one account.
- **New for 2010:** The new Annual BSA Health & Medical Record is due upon arrival at camp - do not send to the Service Center. All youth & adults must have the new Annual BSA Health & Medical Record upon arrival at camp. The new Annual BSA Health & Medical Record is valid for 1 year from the date signed by a physician for both youth & adults. No camper is allowed at camp without the new Annual BSA Health & Medical Record!
- Any outstanding unit balances must be paid upon arrival at camp. Camp reserves the right to limit attendance to Scouts & Adults declared on the May 7th unit roster. Campsites may have more than 1 troop assigned.
- Please review the LHAC Refund Policy prior to your arrival at camp. Camp fees can be transferred to new campers or adult leaders.
